### What should you expect?

- On-site counseling and related-agency support services are made available to students and parents daily.
- A Person-Centered Plan emerges into a transition plan that is aligned with the student's career pathway, daily schedule, and educational development plan.
- Charles R. Drew has a student-operated food program where students harvest vegetables in the school's garden and outdoor Hoop House, then prepare meals onsite.
- Students attending the transition center earn a certificate of completion and are placed with community businesses such as: Karmanos Cancer Institute, Veterans Hospital, TJ Maxx, Harold's Place Hair Shop, auto repair shops, and more.
